Welcome Back!!



We are so excited to be back at the center!! We have missed your children immensely and could not wait to see their faces!! There are some changes to be aware of:

1. Each morning when you arrive you will proceed to the back of the driveway up the ramp. There are blue painted lines separating spaces 6-feet apart, to keep families distance on arrival. Miss Patti will greet you outside the door where you will need to fill out a form with questions about your child's health. When child is cleared to come in the center another staff member will take your child into their designated classroom. You will then leave down the stairs.

2. Parents are encouraged to write notes to your child's teacher in their journal or a note informing them of anything they may need to know for your child's day, such as when they last had a diaper change or used the bathroom, how they slept the night before and any information you feel like the teacher will need to know. Parents may also call during the day to speak with the teachers to check in and see how things are going.

3. When coming to pick your child up, please call the center ahead of time and a designated staff member, will get your child, and their belongings from the classroom and bring them out to you. You may need to be in a line if so please stay distanced by standing on a blue line. Again when you leave you may go down the stairs to avoid other families on the ramp.

4. Masks for the children over the age of 2 are encouraged. PLEASE send in 2 masks with your child each day and we will encourage, but not force, them to wear them. We also have mask if you do forget yours. Masks will be worn by the staff during the day as well as changing their clothing into scrubs when they arrive and change out of them before they depart. We will also be taken precautions to stay socially distant during these times.

5. It is EXTREMELY important for parents to keep their child home if they have exhibited any symptoms of illness or COVID-19. If your child exhibits any symptoms, such as vomit, diarrhea or fever, while at the center, your child will NEED to be picked up, in a timely manner, and will not be allowed to return until they are symptom free for at least 72 hours and/or have a Doctor's note stating they are Covid-19 free. You may need a doctor's note to return. We understand that this may be a hardship for the families, but we are required by the state to follow these health guidelines during this pandemic.. Thank you for understanding and your patience. It is appreciated!

A Friendly Reminder



For safety reasons, we cannot allow children to wear flip flops or open toe sandals to school. All shoes must have closed toes.
