## Social and Emotional Learning

In child care, young children are not only learning about the ABC's and 123's. They are also learning how to regulate their emotions and get along with others.

Making friends. Showing anger in a healthy way. Figuring out conflicts peacefully. Taking care of someone who has been hurt. Waiting patiently. Following rules. Enjoying the company of others. All of these qualities, and more, describe the arc of healthy social-emotional development.

Like any skill, young children develop these abilities in small steps over time. At the WCCC, we use the Pyramid Model approach to support children develop these skills.

The Pyramid Model is a framework consists of strategies and system supports designed to improve the social emotional competence of young children and reduce behavioral challenges.
