We will be closed in observance of Labor Day on Monday, September 6. We hope you all have a safe and enjoyable holiday!



We are starting a voluntary **free weekly COVID-19 testing program** for the children and staff in our program to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Regular COVID-19 testing of students and staff will help us lower the risk of the disease in our school by finding positive cases of COVID-19 quickly. The testing program will also help identify positive cases in people who do not show any symptoms.
