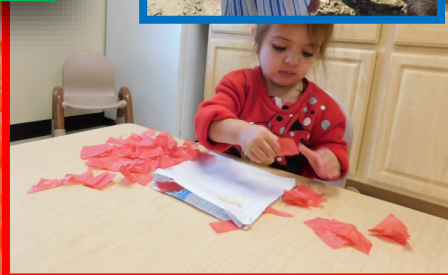

We are offering voluntary **free weekly COVID-19 testing program** for the children and staff in our program to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. A few friendly reminders.....

- If your child will be absent from school please give us a call to let us know. This helps us to keep track of illness and also helps to plan for the day.
- Please label your child's belongings. This really helps to prevent mix-ups. If you arrive at school and need some masking tape and a marker to label an item, just ask.

- In our preschool rooms, we will be sending home a journal each Friday that is used to communicate about your child's experience at the center. We really appreciate when families write back, ask questions or share a bit about what their child is doing at home. If for some reason, you do not receive a journal, please let us know.
