Also, please remember that we do not permit items made with nuts of any kind at the center.

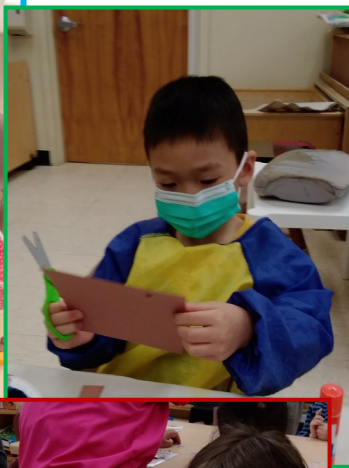


Drop off and pick up reminders
