Back to school night: Tuesday October 18 4:30pm-5:30pm


Come spend some time in your child's classroom, get to know their teachers, and hear about the day!

We would love for you to complete an Ages and Stages Questionnaire. This helps our educators learn a bit more about your child's development and provides valuable insights on what you see at home. The ASQ is designed to be filled out by families, it is user-friendly, and should only take about 10 minutes to complete. It can be filled out on paper or online.
